## Application Deadlines

- Philadelphia Fire Department (PFD) Applicants: February 1, 2020
- Non-PFD Applicants: April 15, 2020

While first seats are offered to Philadelphia Fire Department employees, open seats (those not filled within 5 months of the start date- by February 1<sup>st</sup>) in any cohort of less than 24 students may be offered to other individuals/applicants. The program is not exclusive to PFD employees.

**Admission Information:** Applicants must follow the RHSHS admissions guidelines and pre-admission through post-acceptance requirements. Pre-admission testing starts in November and runs until the class is filled. Applicants will be reviewed for admission once their admission file is complete with all necessary materials.
